SERGEMET VINCENT T.C. SMITH, W337062, Royal New Zealand Infantry Regiment, attached to the Forces Armee' Nationale Khmere (FAR) Training Command, Army Advisory Group, Dong Ba Thin Training Battalion, distinguished himself by exception ally meritorious service against a hostile force from March 1972 through November 1972, while serving with the General Subjects Committee, and later Training Company A-514. As an instructor with the General Subjects Committee, SGT SMITH was primarily involved in navigation, mines and boobytraps, and VG/NVA tactics instruction to groups of Cambodiam leaders and Cambodiam battalions. By his vigorous and inventive approach to training, he was able to draw the maximum participation from his students and thus, outstanding results. He personally revised, updated or rewrote many hours of instruction in order to improve the quality of instruction.
