WHAREMERA, Ch0693, Royal New Zealand Armoured Corps, attached to the Forces Armee' Nationale Khmere (FANK) Training Command, Army Advisory Group, Dong Ba Thin Training Battalion, distinguished himself by meritorious service in connection with military operations against a hostile force during the period March 1972 through November 1972 while serving as a weapons instructor. SOT WHAREMERA was assigned as an instructor with the Weapons Committee. His varied background and experience made him a very flexible instructor, who could undertake all subjects covered by the Weapons Committee. SOT WHAREMERA is intense desire to excel and his contagious high standard of performance quickly won him the respect of his superiors and also of the Cambodian troops. He spent long hours on instruction in extremes of heat with tremendous cheerfulness, thus infecting the troops with a similar response. SOT WHAREMERA gave up much of his own time in devising new ways of increasing interest in the subjects he taught, and by building apparatus which greatly contributed to the assimilation of knowledge by the troops. He developed, in conjunction with another instructor, a method of shortening the shoulder stock of the .30 Cal. Machine Gun. This modification was so successful in improving the standards of firing and handling of the weapon by the Cambodians, that it was adopted as a standard well motivated Noncommissioned Officer, who displays fairness, firmness and friendliness in his work. SCT WHAREMERA's outstanding duty performance is in keeping with the highest traditions of the New Zealand Army and reflects great credit upon himself and the military service.
